- The Ministry of Basic, Higher and Technical Education (MBHTE), through the Basic Education subsector, developed the Bangsamoro Teachers' Professional and Moral Development Standards (BPTMD) as an initial step towards improving pedagogical skills and quality of teaching of teachers. The BTPMD standards are contextualized version of the Philippine Professional Standards for Teachers (PPST) that considered the need to, "institutionalize an education framework that is relevant and responsive to the needs, ideals and aspirations of the Bangsamoro people" (Sec. 16 Art.9 RA11054).
- 2. In view of the above, the Curriculum and Instruction Division (CID) shall conduct the Teachers' Training on relevant and responsive research work under Bangsamoro Junior Scientist Program on November 16-21, 2022 at Cecille's Hotel, Zamboanga City for island divisions while mainland divisions shall be held on November 23-27, 2022 in Cotabato City. This activity aims to capacitate Senior High Schools (SHS) Teachers and provide appropriate teaching and learning pedagogies and platforms for research that is accredited with Continuing Professional Development (CPD) units by the Professionals Regulation Commission (PRC).
- The Bangsamoro Junior Scientist Program (BJSP) is a program of the Ministry in partnership with the University of the Philippines (UP) System and the Ministry of Science and Technology (MOST).
