POLICY GUIDELINES ON THE ISSUANCE OF GOVERNMENT PERMIT TO

OPERATE, RENEWAL, AND RECOGNITION FOR PRIVATE MADRASAH IN

BARMM

- 1. The Bangsamoro Education Code Chapter 2 Section 8 states that the "Bangsamoro Government shall promote and protect the constitutional right of all to quality and accessible education at all levels and to establish, maintain, and support a complete, adequate, and integrated system of education relevant and responsive to the needs, ideals, and aspirations of the Bangsamoro People." It provides the provision for the establishment, maintenance, and supervision of basic education in both the school and madrasah system to meet learning needs and provide the foundation on which subsequent learning can be based.
- With this, the Ministry of Basic, Higher and Technical Education hereby issues the Policy Guidelines on the issuance of Government Permit to Operate, Renewal, and Recognition for Private Madrasah in Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao (BARMM) which was signed on July 7, 2023.
- 3. These guidelines shall provide the legal requirements and standard procedures for the issuance of government permit to operate, renewal, and recognition for Formal Private Madrasah that operates five (5) days a week, Non-Formal Madrasah (Traditional Madrasah) that operates two (2) days a week and Special Institution called Tahfidz Al-Qur-an Centers.
- 4. These policies also seek to harmonize existing issuances of the Department of Education (DepEd) on Muslim education BARMM, with new provisions for more effective and efficient program development, implementation, and evaluation.
- 5. Moreover, these policies shall enable the private Madaris to undertake educational operations through the issuance of government permit to operate and recognition consistent with the National Educational Policies and Standards and in consonance with the existing policies of the Ministry.

- 6. These policy guidelines will remain in force and effect for the duration of the program unless otherwise repealed, amended, or rescinded. All existing DepEd Orders, Ministry Policy for Formal Private Madrasah, and related issuances that are inconsistent with this order are rescinded.
