- The Ministry of Basic, Higher, and Technical Education serves as Co-Chair of the Pathways Steering Committee (PSC) on behalf of the Bangsamoro Government. The PSC is one of two governance bodies of the Education Pathways to Peace in Mindanao Program.
- The PSC is the highest governing body overseeing the implementation of the Pathways program. It is responsible for setting the program's strategic direction, including approving annual work plans. The Australian Embassy Manila and the Department of Education co-chairs the PSC with the MBHTE.
- In reference to a letter from the Australian Embassy dated November 27, 2023, signed by **Ms. Georgina Harley-Cavanough, First Secretary for Development**, the next PSC meeting will be held on December 15, 2023, in Davao City. The meeting will focus on Pathways' next phase program, including the findings and recommendations of the independent midterm review, the program's three-year direction, and its 18-month workplan. Attached is the letter and agenda for your reference.
- The Ministry must participate in this meeting to ensure that Pathways' next phase aligns with the Ministry's priorities and that any educational initiatives in the BARMM are rooted in the cultural, social, and economic realities of the communities they serve. **In this regard, you are directed to attend the PSC as part of the MBHTE's delegation.**
