GENDER EQUALITY DISABILITY INCLUSION, AND SOCIAL INCLUSION

1. As part of the Ministry of Basic, Higher and Technical Education's (MBHTE) efforts to respond to Republic Act 11650, An act instituting a policy of inclusion and services for learners with disabilities in support of inclusive education, establishing inclusive learning resource centers of learners with disabilities in all schools' districts, municipalities and cities, providing for standards, appropriating funds therefor, and for other purposes, a Gender Equality, Disability Equity, and Social Inclusion (GEDSI) Analysis shall be conducted to help determine more targeted interventions for the Bangsamoro learners by looking at the issues on gender and development, disability, and social exclusion from available data.

- The activity shall be held on January 8-12, 2024 (inclusive of travel dates) in Davao City (specific venue shall be communicated directly to participants once finalized).
- 3. The activity aims to:
 - a. discuss and understand the situation of disadvantaged learners in BARMM from BEMIS, Reach Every Child, testimonials from lived experiences, and other sources;
 - b. analyze what are the barriers to gender equality, disability equity, and social inclusion, including the sharing of relevant and responsive practices that address these barriers, through a structured and formative process; and
 - c. develop a strategy and formulate an action plan based on the results of the analysis.
- 4. The conduct of this activity is supported by the Education Pathways to Peace in Mindanao. Attached is the list of participants (Annex A) and program flow (Annex B) for reference.
