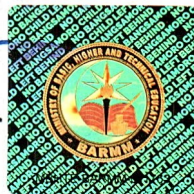

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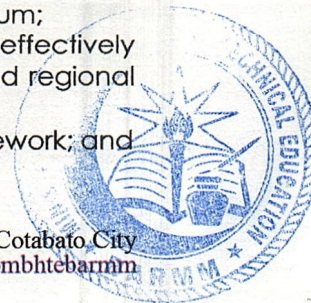

SUBJECT : **WORKSHOP ON THE DEVELOPMENT OF K-12 BASIC EDUCATION CURRICULUM CONTEXTUALIZATION FRAMEWORK**

DATE : February 29, 2024

1. Article IX Section 16 of Republic Act No. 11054 or the Bangsamoro Organic Law, states that the Bangsamoro Government shall establish an education framework that is relevant and responsive to the needs, ideals, and aspirations of the Bangsamoro people. Similarly, the Bangsamoro Act No. 18, states that Peace Education shall be institutionalized at all levels of education (Article 1 Chapter 2, Section 8. Declaration of Policies). Specifically, it states that Peace Education shall be an integral part of the Basic Education Curriculum designed to instill in the learners the culture of nonviolent, social justice, and respect for human rights, freedom, and inclusivity (Article 5 Chapter 2, Section 55, 56). Further, the education system in the Bangsamoro shall adhere to the following education principles such as inclusivity, equity, rights-based, rooted in context, integrated, balanced, and Moral Governance.
2. Following the recently convened workshop for the formulation of the K-12 Basic Education Curriculum Contextualization Framework in Davao City, the Office of the Directorate General for Basic Education (DGBE), through the Curriculum and Instructions Division (CID) with the support from Education Pathways to Peace in Mindanao (Pathways), shall conduct its **phase two activity on the workshop on the contextualization of the K-12 Basic Education MATATAG Curriculum** on March 5-9, 2024 (inclusive of travel days) in Cagayan de Oro City (specific venue shall be communicated directly to participants once finalized).
3. The activity aims to:
  - a. facilitate a comprehensive understanding of the key components and principles underpinning the K-12 Basic Education MATATAG Curriculum;
  - b. equip participants with the necessary skills and knowledge to effectively contextualize the curriculum within diverse educational settings and regional contexts;
  - c. develop a K-12 Basic Education Curriculum Contextualization Framework; and







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- d. foster collaboration and knowledge-sharing among education workers fostering a collective approach to the successful implementation of the contextualized curriculum.
4. Food, accommodation, transportation, and per diem of the participants will be covered by the Pathways, subject to their regular accounting and auditing procedures. The Pathways will provide a vehicle (van) for all participating divisions. The Division Office shall be the point of origin as the basis of transportation back and forth.
