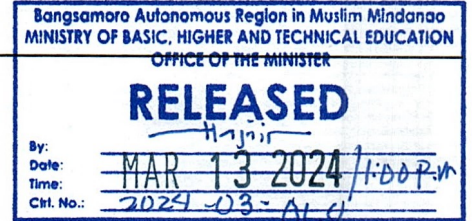

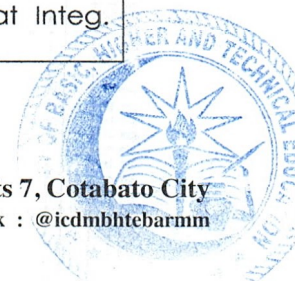

SUBJECT : **TRAINING OF TEACHERS, HEAD TEACHERS, AND SCHOOL PERSONNEL ON INCLUSIVE EDUCATION THROUGH ANTICIPATORY ACTION AND EDUCATION IN EMERGENCIES AND DROPOUT REDUCTION PROGRAM**

DATE : March 11, 2024

1. The Ministry of Basic, Higher and Technical Education (MBHTE), in partnership with Plan International Pilipinas Foundation Inc., is committed to working constructively to ensure inclusive disaster preparedness and management for the continuity of learning among students during times of crisis.
2. Through our support for the AA Project entitled "**Strengthening Structures for Anticipatory Humanitarian Action for Gender-Responsive and Inclusive Disaster Management in the Philippines**", Plan International Pilipinas will conduct a **three-day training program for 30 teachers from Elementary, Secondary, Alternative Learning System (ALS), and Madrasah from the municipalities of Datu Blah Sinsuat and Upi**, both located in Maguindanao del Norte. The training program will focus on inclusive education through anticipatory action and the development of effective Dropout Reduction Program (DORP).
