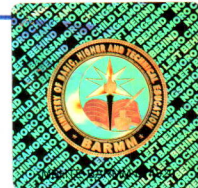

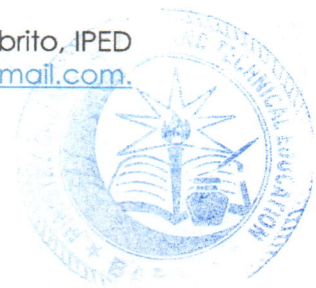

SUBJECT : **REVIEW AND FINALIZATION OF INDIGENOUS PEOPLES EDUCATION GUIDELINES**

DATE : May 31, 2024

1. The Bureau of Indigenous Peoples Education (BIPEd) of the Ministry of Basic, Higher and Technical Education's (MBHTE) Directorate General for Basic Education is enhancing its ability to carry out programs for indigenous peoples education (IPED) by closely assessing the needs for establishing the standards for IPED schools.
2. In order to ensure that educational practices are in line with sustainable development goals, a **Finalization Review on the IPED Guidelines** will be conducted on **June 8-11, 2024** (inclusive of travel dates) in Zamboanga City. This will help address the educational inequalities that Indigenous learners often encounter.

4. The activity is in partnership with the Education Pathways to Peace in Mindanao program (Pathways) and Consortium Bangsamoro Civil Society (CBCS).
