- Pursuant to Article V, Section 52 of the Bangsamoro Education Code (Bangsamoro Autonomy Act No. 18), which states the power and functions of the Ministry of Basic, Higher and Technical Education in basic education to which the development of standard assessments and tools is included, the Office of the Directorate General for Basic Education (DGBE), with support from the World Vision, will be conducting the Brigada Pagbasa: Unlock Literacy Classroom Observation Tool Contextualization Workshop in Cotabato City on October 13-16, 2024 (inclusive of travel dates).
